WRIT OF ELECTION

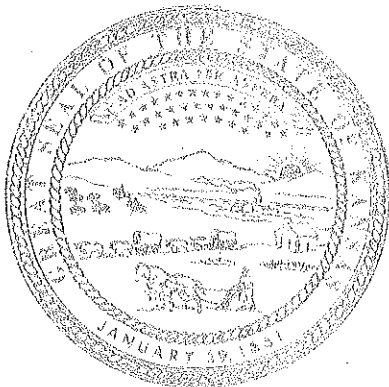
WHEREAS, as of January 23, 2017, a vacancy exists in the representation of the State of Kansas in the House of Representatives of the United States in the Fourth Congressional District, due to the resignation of the Honorable Mike Pompeo; and

WHEREAS, Article 1, Section 2, Clause 4 of the United States Constitution provides that, upon a vacancy in representation in the House of Representatives, the executive authority of the State shall issue a writ of election to fill the vacancy; and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 25-3501 and 3502, as recently amended by House Bill 2017, provide that upon such a vacancy the Governor shall within five days proclaim the date of an election to fill the vacancy, with said election to be held not less than 75 days or more than 90 days after the Governor's proclamation.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Kansas, I hereby proclaim that an election shall be held to fill the unexpired term for the office of Member of the United States House of Representatives, Fourth Congressional District, on April 11, 2017.

This document shall be delivered to the Secretary of State and shall become effective immediately.
