After the prayer by Terry Mayhew, Bert called the meeting to order.

Ron moved to approve the consent agenda and John seconded, motion carried 3-0.

Gunnar Stauth came to give R&B updates. Items discussed were oil distributor, mowing tractor bid, and interest rates on grader leases. Next, they asked Gunnar what the snow routes are for the County. Gunnar explained they do the bus and mail routes first, then they start on County roads that residents live on, and then the others last.

Matt Christenson came to present a quote for security cameras and mirrors for the entry at the Commons. Next, Matt explained the recording system the District Court has and after some discussion, they decided not to use the old system due to all the hardware that would need to be purchased in order to operate the recorder. With the upcoming renewal of EMC Insurance in May, the Clerk reminded the Commissioners they requested to look into removing coverage from the Library, Extension, Media Center and Museum. After some discussion, by consensus they agreed to keep paying for the insurance from those listed above.

During Commissioner Discussion, the Clerk asked for clarification on the Belvidere mowing for this year. By consensus, they agreed to have the Clerk write a letter to Ed Koger and ask him if he is interested in mowing the property again. Next, the Clerk wanted to talk about guidelines on closing the Courthouse for weather due to the storm that is supposed to be coming through tonight. After some discussion by consensus, they asked the Clerk to coordinate with Ray Stegman and Gunnar Stauth on delays or closings after the Commissioners have been contacted.

Gunnar came back to discuss the new Grader lease prices from Foley. He reported the new lease for the first grader would be \$22,971.62 and the second grader lease would be \$21,665.56. Bert moved to accept the leases with Foley and John seconded, motion carried 3-0.
