During Commissioner Discussion, the Clerk presented a letter from Southwest Kansas Area Agency on Aging (SWKAAA) requesting \$1000 for 2014 and informed them they paid \$700 last year. John moved to pay \$700 to SWKAAA and Ron seconded, motion carried 3-0. Next, the Clerk reported that the liquor tax the County received last year was \$486.03 that Sheldon Carpenter asked about at the last meeting he attended. By consensus of the Commissioners, they agreed to continue doing what they have done with the liquor tax dollars.
