7^{th} Ave & H St; 45^{th} Ave & G St; SW 150^{th} Ave & G St; 53^{rd} Ave & G St; 49^{th} Ave & D St;
WHEREAS, Safety Officials from the County are in agreement that signage controls should be erected at the aforementioned locations;
WHEREAS, engineering judgment indicates that a stop signs should be installed at 7 th Ave & H St, and at SW 150 th Ave & G. St;
WHEREAS, engineering judgment indicates that a yield signs should be installed at 45 th Ave & G St, 53 rd Ave and G. St, and 49 th Ave & D ST
