THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF KIOWA COUNTY, KANSAS SHALL SUBMIT TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE COUNTY AT THE NEXT GENERAL ELECTION THE FOLLOWING PROPOSITION:

Shall sale of alcoholic liquor by the individual drink in Kiowa County be allowed in public places where at least 30% of the gross receipts are from sales of food for consumption on the premises and prohibited in all other public places.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF KIOWA COUNTY, KANSAS:

THAT Kiowa County is a duly organized county within the State of Kansas and, pursuant to the home-rule authority vested in said county by K.S.A. 19-101a and K.S.A. 41-2646.

THAT upon the adoption of this resolution the county election officer shall cause this proposition to be placed on the ballot at the next succeeding state general election which occurs more than ninety (90) days after the resolution is adopted.
