## RESOLUTION NO. 2010-20

## RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF KIOWA COUNTY, KANSAS, CREATING A FOUR WAY STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF 33<sup>RD</sup> AVENUE AND J STREET

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 19-101a, and amendments thereto, provides that the Board of County Commissioners shall have home rule authority to legislate on matters of local concern; and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 8-2002, and amendments thereto, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to regulate and restrict the use of the highways within their jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has received concerns from the public, and, having received information and heard recommendations from the Kiowa County Road and Bridge Supervisor and the Kiowa County Sheriff regarding safety concerns at the intersection of 33<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and J Street in Kiowa County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, after discussion, have determined that the intersection of 33<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and J Street yield signs as currently posted do not adequately protect the public safety and general well being. It is in the best interests of public safety and is reasonable and advisable to post this intersection as a four way stop.

NOW, THEREFORE, based upon all matters known and presented to it, the Board of County Commissioners finds and concludes as follows: The Road and Bridge Supervisor shall post and maintain the intersection of 33<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and J Street in Kiowa County, Kansas as a four way stop.

This is an ordinary home rule resolution and shall become effective upon its publication in the official newspaper of the County, and the prohibitions and restrictions provided in this resolution shall become effective, after publication, upon the posting of traffic control signs as required by this resolution.
