WHEREAS, the Board of Kiowa County Commissioners desire to adopt and establish a system of Position Classification and Pay Plan policies; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Kiowa County Commissioners believe that adopting a Position Classification and Pay Plan for all non-elected Kiowa County employees, excluding those positions described in Section 2.10 of the plan, is in the best interest of County Employees and the County itself;
