INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into pursuant to K.S.A. 12-2904. Whereby, the County of Kiowa on this 31 day of January, 2014, hereby agrees to enter into a contract with other counties in the Sixteenth Judicial District who shall sign a like agreement for the following purpose.

- 1. To join and participate in the Santa Fe Trail Community Correction Program as mandated by Senate Bill 49 of the 1989 Legislative Session.
- 2. This agreement shall continue so long as there is legislative funding for the services provided.
- 3. Pursuant to K.S.A. 75-5290 et seq, the organization created will be the Santa Fe Trail Community Correction Program which will consist of all counties in the Sixteenth Judicial District who sign the Interlocal Agreement. This organization will have all the powers and authorities as defined in K.S.A. 75-5290 et seq, which is known as the Community Correction Act.
- 4. Any county may upon their own, choose to withdraw from this community corrections program pursuant to the terms of K.S.A. 75-52,106.
