A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF KIOWA COUNTY, KANSAS, REGARDING THE USE OF RECORDING DEVICES AT PUBLIC MEETINGS.


WHEREAS, Pursuant to K.S.A. 75-4318(3)(e), the use of cameras, photographic lights and recording devices shall not be prohibited at any meeting open to the public, but such use shall be subject to reasonable rules designed to insure the orderly conduct of the proceedings at such meeting.

WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF KIOWA COUNTY, KANSAS, that the Board of County Commissioners of Kiowa County, Kansas find and order as follows:

1. That any members of the public that desires to record any County meetings that are open to the public shall have an operator present at all times the recording devices are in use to operate and be responsible for said equipment; and
2. That said operator shall insure that all recording devices are removed, and all cameras and microphones present in the meeting room are turned off during executive sessions; and
3. That the operator shall be responsible for removing the recording devices when the public meeting is adjourned.
4. That the County shall not be responsible for any recording equipment used by a member of the public.




